Dear Ministry Partner,

In life we can be the victims of dual messages, if we are not careful and listen to sound doctrine.

Now, we know what has happened, we know what is going on and we can know more into the future, if we keep our hand in the Master's Hand. Please remember that we serve a Miraculous God. Greater is He that is in you than he that is in the world. Remember, you can do all things through Christ, Who strengthens you. If nothing else I want you to see that you are somebody who is important to God. I want you to know that God really cares about you.

It is my fervent prayer that the Holy Spirit uses what you read in this letter to help you see your relationship with Jesus Christ in a new and exciting way. Now when Jesus spoke to the disciples in John 13:1-16, He spoke to them about being servants. Friends, my brothers and sisters, He did not stop there. See, He told them more about who they were in Him. In John 15: 14-15, Jesus elevated them to friends and then in John 20:17, Jesus elevated them yet again.

In these scriptures' Jesus is addressing the position of being "servant-minded". When Jesus spoke to His disciples and called them servants, He was teaching them a truth because He knew their thinking. . . .He was working to change their natural or carnal minds, in an effort to get them to conform to His thinking. All you have to do is step into FAITH. Make the decision right now to move beyond servant and beyond friend to the position of BROTHER, you will move into the position of UNLIMITED RESOURCES. See, we are brothers and sisters with Jesus. We have been adopted into His family.

In conclusion, God sees you as more than a servant, more than friend, He sees us as brothers and sisters, joint heirs with Jesus Christ. Everything that is His is yours. His Divine Health can be your Divine Health. If Jesus has it.... You have it by FAITH.
