Dear Friends,

Two sisters told the Lord, that if, He had been there, their brother would not have died such faith is deeply moving, but there is room for greater expansion, greater increase of faith. See David knew the Lord and he knew that wherever he went the Lord was was with him, wherein Psalm 139, he inquires of the Lord, "whither shall I go from Thy Spirit? Or whither shall I flee from Thy presence? The thought here is where can one go to get away from the Lord and he expresses his true feelings when he tells the Lord that he could dwell in the uttermost parts of the sea, if he ascended up to the heavens or even made his bed in hell, David knew that God would be there.

Now these two examples really show a resemblance to David and his problems with a jealous Saul, but the larger picture is that God is still here doing great and wonderful things, it shows that prayer is answered and lastly, it it my opinion shows not a store bought faith but the life changing faith we need to not only survive this world but to exceed.

My travels are many and I encounter a diverse, robust mixture of people and problems and often I share with people one of my wishes, I tell them I wish they could see what I have seen, been where I have been and know what I know. (A disclaimer note: I am not perfect, try as I might I will never be, I do not know all I should know as I matter of fact I am hard pressed to write a letter without the assistance of spell check, but the redeeming quality, I try; I give a 100% effort every time and if anybody should ask you who I am, tell them I am redeemed).
